

Where is Armageddon?

Armageddon is the Hebrew name for Mt. Megiddo, 60 miles north of Jerusalem. The battle will rage on the nearby plains, site of Barak's victory over the Canaanites (Judges 4), and Gideon's victory over the Midianites (Judges 7). Napoleon called this valley the greatest battlefield he had ever seen. But the Battle of Armageddon will not be limited to the Megiddo plains; it will encompass the length of the State of Israel (Rev. 14:20).

What is Armageddon?

The Battle of Armageddon is a "winner takes all" war between Satan with his demonic and Caliphate forces, against God, with His holy angels and Israel! The battle rages at the end of the 7-year Tribulation and ended when Jesus returns at His Second Coming.

B. Valley of Megiddo, Flooded with Blood - Rev. 14:9-10; 17:12-14

A Bloody Mess

The severity of the slaughter is indicated by the blood of those killed splattering 4-5 ft. high - as high as the bridles of the horses in the battle (Rev. 14:20). The tremendous volume of blood forms troughs 4-5 ft. high throughout the 180 mile long battlefield area. The battle runs from Armageddon in the north to Edom in the south.



The Great Earthquake

The 7th bowl judgment from God is a great earthquake that immediately precedes the second coming of Christ. It's described as the worst calamity in the history of the world (Rev 16:17-21). God will punctuate the completion of His wrath with one, final, devastating earthquake. The powerful earthquake radically alters earth's surface, preparing it for a more worship-friendly environment during the millennial reign of Christ.

All earth's topography will be altered. Mountains are flattened, islands disappear and Israel, especially Jerusalem, is transformed to prepare the city for its central place of worship in the millennial kingdom. Because of her repentance, Jerusalem will be raised up and made more beautiful as the capitol city of earth for Jesus, the reigning King.

- b. The uneven terrain around Jerusalem becomes a flat plain vs. 10
- c. A fountain under Jerusalem unleashes two new rivers vs. 8; Ezek. 47:1-12

d. Jerusalem becomes an elevated, plateau and center of worship - vs. 16
